WINE DESCRIPTION

A powerful reserve red wine from the Kamptal, in the nose dried fruit, vanilla from the wood, some jam, on the palate dense, full-bodied, well-integrated tannin structure, rounded off by beautiful roasted aromas.

Edwin Schreibeis joined our family winery Schreibeis in the middle of 2014 and has been responsible for the wines and the vinification in the cellar since the vintage 2017.
