Completely frozen grapes are harvested and pressed for the ice wine. This separates frozen water from the juice, creating a concentrated dessert wine. An exciting, tempting fragrance of sweet fruits, syrup, caramel, mandarin wedges; Great finesse on the palate and a refined sweetness and acidity that continues indefinitely; full of style, elegance and class in every respect.
