Pale yellow, persistent, fine-pearled mousse, fine fruity aromas of wild berries, delicate minerality combined with buttery brioche. Fine acidity, well balanced with a creamy, full-bodied texture, elegant, dry and invigorating on the palate. Fresh citrus notes on the finish with lingering minerality.
