Karl Steininger: On the nose, ripe Riesling notes with dark spice from black tea. On the palate, almost lively with a delicate fruit melt, it impresses with a subtle interplay of acidity and sweetness, dancing on the palate. Inviting for another sip, it lingers. 19/20 points
