

Pet Nat – Zweigelt Rosé 2023



Wine Description

Pet Nat is a short form for Pétillants naturels, which means naturally sparkling. For this product, we bottle the fermenting juice and leave it with the yeasts and the natural sugar in the bottle so that the fermentation continues in the bottle and produces natural carbon dioxide. It is a very natural way to produce sparkling wine - without any additives. The grapes for our Pet Nat Zweigelt grow on a clay soil at about 320m above sea level. The vines are about 20 years old. Important for Pet Nat is the time of bottling. You need still some sugar and enough working yeasts so that the fermentation can continue in the bottle. Our Pet Nat Zweigelt is a fruity, very dry sparkling wine with an adstringend finish. Hence, it is a good aperitif and a perfect party drink.
