An aroma of juicy pear and green apple. A creamy/dense texture on the palate with the pear again present. Acidity and spices bring about a varied structure. A very juicy and concentrated Grüner Veltliner.

Weingut Mayer am Pfarrplatz, the epitome of Viennese Heurigen culture, has a centuries-old tradition crafting the finest Viennese wines in Heiligenstadt since 1683. The wine-growing region of Vienna covers a surface area of approx. 640 hectares. Our village wines grow in the vineyards of Grinzing, Hernals and Wiener Nussberg. Our wines from the single sites Preussen and Langteufel classify as Erste Lage.
