In traditional Japanese aesthetics, Wabi-sabi (題型) is a world view centered on the acceptance of transience and imperfection. The aesthetic is sometimes described as one of beauty that is "imperfect, impermanent, and incomplete". It is a concept derived from the Buddhist teaching of the three marks of existence (題題 sanbōin), specifically impermanence (題題 mujō), suffering (題 ku) and emptiness or absence of self-nature (图 kū).

Characteristics of the wabi-sabi aesthetic include asymmetry, roughness, simplicity, economy, austerity, modesty, intimacy, and appreciation of the ingenuous integrity of natural objects and processes.

In today's Japan, the meaning of wabi-sabi is often condensed to "wisdom in natural simplicity."
